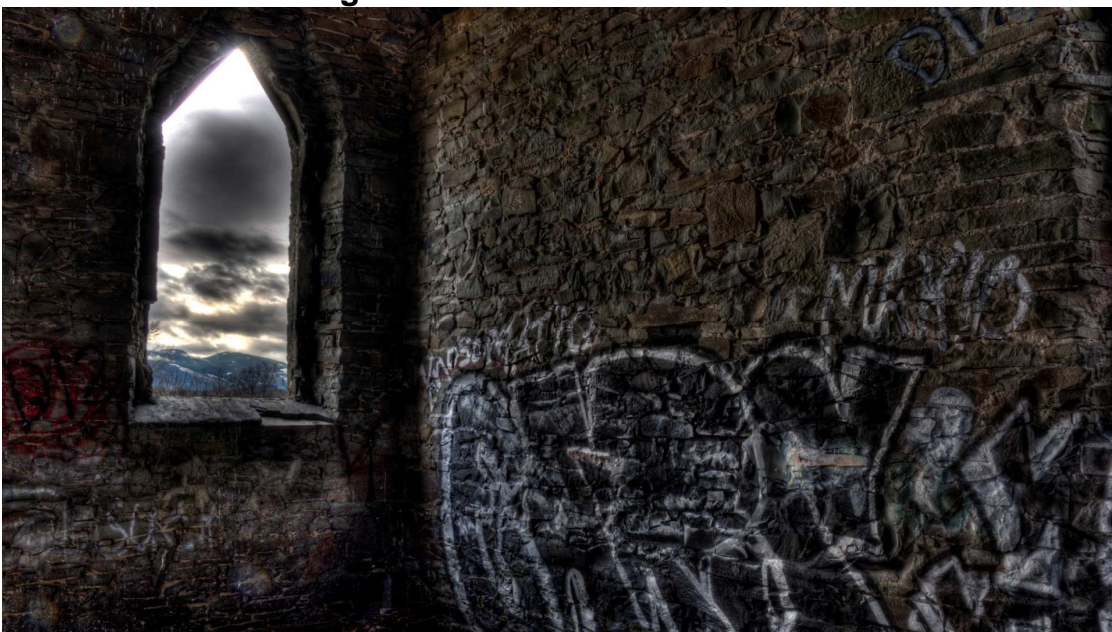
First Place Pat Haugen "Framed Reflection"
